ABOUT THE PROGRAM

NHF's most recent recuperative care program was launched in the city of Oxnard in collaboration with its site partner Mercy House. At the start of 2021, NHF and Mercy House opened this 70-bed site, 20 beds of which NHF operates as recuperative care. Guests stay 60-90 while receiving medical oversight and comprehensive social services. Funded through California's Project Homekey, this program is designed to transition individuals into permanent supportive housing.
