ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Since November 2018, NHF has welcomed guests into its flagship Pico-Union Recuperative Care facility. Neighboring Downtown Los Angeles, Koreatown and University Park, this site provides 58 beds in one of LA County's most dense neighborhoods. A a model for all its recuperative care sites, this program is founded in housing-first, trauma-informed care, and harm reduction principles, and provides medical oversight, and care coordination to individuals experiencing homelessness in a safe, private space that enables healing, wellness, and community-connectedness.
