## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

In response to the growing needs of people experiencing homelessness, NHF expanded its reach to the city of Ventura in 2017. Through a public-private collaboration with local hospitals and the County of Ventura, NHF offers this 12-bed program to guests with no where to recuperate post-hospital stay. Grounded in harm reduction and trauma informed care principles, NHF offers medical oversight and comprehensive social support to residents during an average 14-day length of stay.
