A 43,000 sq ft interim housing facility for 148 older adults in CD6 who are experiencing homelessness, community center with space for myriad events, ongoing programming, and shared space for needed residential and supportive services.



Proven Model of Recuperative Care

Housing-first, traumainformed care program that helps older adults heal.



Helping Older Adults Find a Home

Social workers match guests to permanent housing options.



Intergenerational Programming

Bringing together young and old for mutually-beneficial life experiences.



Tackling Social Isolation

Providing a place where older adults with past trauma can engage with others in a safe setting.



Built Environment Improvements

Park, street, sidewalk, and lot improvements for a better neighborhood experience.



Hospice Options: End of Life Housing

For older adults who would otherwise spend their last days on the street.



Hub for Community Engagement

In addition to providing jobs, NHF will engage a resident leader group to address local policy concerns.
